

Culinary Sage



Salvia officinalis

- **Use:** A small evergreen subshrub, with woody stems, grayish leaves, and blue to purplish flowers. Numerous medicinal and culinary uses. Deer resistant and drought tolerant!
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
 - **Growth:** Moderate grower 2-3' tall x 3' wide.
 - **Hardiness:** 4-9, Perennial , Shrubby
 - **Foliage:** Evergreen.
 - **Flower:** Purple flowers appear summer-fall.
- Edible sage is good for use in cooking and great in the perennial border.**
