

Mexican Mint Marigold/ Spanish Tarragon



Tagetes lucida

- **Use:** Sweet licorice flavor brightens salads and main dishes. The edible, pretty, golden-yellow flowers bloom all summer and can be used to garnish desserts and drinks with the same sweet licorice flavor as the leaves. Thrives in warmer climates where French tarragon will not grow.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-24" tall and 12-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; The leaves have a fragrance similar to anise or licorice.
- **Flower:** Golden yellow flowers blooming in summer to late fall, it is excellent for attracting migrating butterflies.



Loves the heat and blooms until late October frosts!
