

# Hi Ho Silver Thyme



Attractive garden plant brings classic thyme flavor to chicken, vegetables and sauces.



## *Thymus argenteus* 'Hi Ho Silver'

- **Use:** A perfect addition to any herb garden. Strong white variegation throughout the foliage adds color to mixed borders. Accented with small pink blooms in summer. Leaves can be used in any recipe calling for thyme.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established. Good drainage is key, red clay must be amended with sand and fine rock for best results. No standing water.
- **Growth:** Reaches 6 to 12 inches tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10, Perennial / Herb
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Has lovely variegation and works well as an ornamental. Hi Ho Silver has brighter white variegation than other silver thymes. It can be used for any recipe calling for the flavor of thyme and works well in a windowsill herb garden.
- **Flower:** Tiny white flowers appear in early spring.
