

# Hello Darlin' Blueberry Bush



***Vaccinium corymbosum 'Hello Darlin' FL09-216' PPAF***  
**(Southern Highbush)**

- **Use:** This beautiful blueberry hybrid offers year-round interest even when not full of berries. Its compact dense foliage turns dark red in fall. Fragrant blooms arrive early in spring followed by large amounts of delicious blueberries.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers light, acid soils (pH 4.5-5.2) with high organic matter (20-50%) are preferred, unlike most fruit crops.
- **Growth:** Moderate, 4-5' tall and 3-4' wide; best if pruned.
- **Hardiness: Zone** 6-9; shrub (Will produce as far south as South GA and FLA as well.)
- **Pollination:** Will set fruit without a pollinator, but better fruit set with multiple plants.
- **Flower:** Small white blooms in spring setting fruit in June. Extremely productive. Well-suited to subtropical conditions, and can be grown indoors as a potted plant. Needs 100-150 chill-hours for blooming.
