

Pixie Pinot Meunier Purple Grape



Vitis vinifera 'Pixie Pinot Meunier Purple'

- **Use:** Grow miniature clusters of grapes right on your coffee table or patio! Pixie Grape is a dwarf grapevine that grows just 14 to 20 inches tall and continually produces miniature clusters of grapes all year long. Though it can be grown in the ground, it really shines in containers. The plant is very shallow rooting, so container options are nearly endless - get creative!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in full sun. Treat it as a houseplant that can be grown outside for the summer and, in cold climates, carried inside for the winter where it will continue to grow and set fruit. Unlike traditional grapes, these vines begin producing fruit the first year planted.
- **Growth:** Grows only 14-20" tall
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green leaves
- **Fruit:** The purple fruits have few seeds and a delicious sweet-tart flavor that can be enjoyed fresh from the vine or used as a garnish - perfect for wine connoisseurs.
