

Tara Muscadine



- Produces good size quality fruit. This muscadine is excellent for all uses and is also an excellent pollinator as well.
- Disease resistant.
- Ripens uniformly and mid-season.
- 17% sugar

- **Use:** The first thing you'll notice about Tara Scuppernong grapes are their sheer size-and huge quantities. The vine's perfectly round, bronze-colored grapes grow to about the size of a quarter, and shine in the sun with the same brilliance. Self-fertile 80 lbs. per vine.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in full sun. Muscadine grapes grow well on a wide range of soils but best results are obtained from well-drained sandy loams with a pH of 5.5 to 6.5. They will not tolerate low, wet ground.
- **Growth:** Plant in full sun at 15-20 ft. apart on strong trellises.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green above and green tinged yellow beneath, the leaves are glossy on both sides, becoming firm and subglabrous at maturity.
- **Flower:** Produces round 1-inch grape fruits, ripening uniformly early to mid season, have thick skins and a very full-bodied, musky taste that has been appreciated in homemade wine for generations.
