

Welder Muscadine



Welder is a medium sized bronze variety that's great for fresh eating, juice or wine making. The vines are so prolific and with such an extended harvest time, you'll get three harvests of grapes! When juiced out fresh Welder's flavor is quite similar to the flavor of commercial grape juice.

Vitis rotundifolia 'Welder'

- **Use:** Red Self-fertile. Vine vigorous. Quality very good. Large clusters. High yields. Ripens mid-season. Great for juice, wine and fresh fruit. 17% sugar.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in full sun. Muscadine grapes grow well on a wide range of soils but best results are obtained from well-drained sandy loams with a pH of 5.5 to 6.5. They will not tolerate low, wet ground.
- **Growth:** Plant in full sun at 15-20 ft. apart on strong trellises.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 7-10; Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green above and green tinged yellow beneath, the leaves are glossy on both sides, becoming firm and subglabrous at maturity.
- **Flower:** Produces one of the largest berries out of the self-fertile cultivars. This mid-season grape has excellent flavor. It is similar to Fry in flavor, color, and size.
