
Lily of the Nile



Agapanthus africanus

- <u>Use</u>: Agapanthus bears round heads of blue flowers on long, stout stems during summer. Mulch well in winter with a layer of bark or leaves at the base of the plant. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. During the summer, be prepared to give them plenty of water. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 18 in. tall and wide, 2½ ft. tall flower stalks.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 7-10 Perennial Mulch around plant in the winter.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The leaves are long and strap-shaped and look like large amaryllis leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> The stem holding the head of flowers may be three feet or longer. Deep-blue orbs of blossoms are magnificent in the summer. The older they get the more they bloom.
