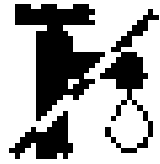


# Black Adder Hyssop



## *Agastache 'Black Adder'*

- **Use:** Selected for its profusion of long lasting, deep violet blue flower spikes, that appear from July to September and fragrant foliage. Prefers average to dry locations, and is a butterfly magnet. A long flowering, heat and drought tolerant, as well as insect and disease resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** They should be grown in well-drained soil in full sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 3' tall and 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous Deep green foliage is lobed, slightly serrated, and licorice scented
- **Flower:** Flower bracts are navy blue and flowers are a paler sky blue; offering a remarkable color contrast from May until late fall.

Drought tolerant, deer resistant, and attracts butterflies!
