## Agastache 'Kudos Mandarin'

- <u>Use:</u> The show begins in spring, when the new foliage emerges a deep shade of bronze. Licorice scented, it is very lush on compact plants. By the end of spring the plants are topped with rosy orange blooms that attract every honeybee, butterfly, and hummingbird in the neighborhood. Deer, slugs, and other nibblers leave this aromatic plant alone, and the blooms continue all the way into autumn.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: In full sun and well-drained soil, they happily shrug off both summer heat and early frosts. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 17-20" tall & wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 5-10 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Touch the foliage and scents of licorice, root beer or mint fill the air on these grey-green leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> It offers orange and pink flowers throughout the summer on a tidy plant that grows 10 inches tall and wide.
