

# Purple Haze Hyssop



## *Agastache 'Purple Haze'*

- **Use:** Hummingbird Mint is an appealing perennial for summer through fall color in a sun-loving garden. It will be a magnet for pollinators from late spring until fall, yet ignored by deer and rabbits. They are equally good in the border and as a candidate for container growing. The better the drainage, the happier the plant. Scented foliage is good for flavoring drinks and drying. A customer advises us that her Goldfinches are wild for Agastache seed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** In full sun and well-drained soil, they happily shrug off both summer heat and early frosts. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 3' tall and 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 6-10; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Touch the foliage and scents of licorice, root beer or mint fill the air on these grey-green leaves. Intensely fragrant foliage.
- **Flower:** Beautiful, dark blue-violet flowers on graceful spikes. It blooms much of the summer and attracts bees and butterflies. Can also be used as a cut flower. Blooms late spring to fall frosts.
