

# 'Black Scallop' Ajuga / Bugleweed



A great groundcover for shady areas.



## *Ajuga 'Black Scallop'*

- **Use:** Attractive ground cover with colorful foliage and spikes of blue flowers in spring. Groundcover for shade with cream and gold variegation. Spikes of small blue flowers in late spring. Black Scallops are a knock out in patio pots, combos, and as a striking accent with white, gold or light-colored plants.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 4" tall, and keeps spreading.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9 perennial. Very easy to grow!
- **Foliage:** Has 'dark as night' foliage with gorgeously scalloped leaves. Many winters it will be evergreen, but in a cold winter may go dormant.
- **Flower:** Small blue spikes in late spring.
