

Variegated Shell Ginger



Very easy to grow! Lush tropical look great with banana trees and Mandevilla.

Alpinia zerumbet 'Variegata'

- **Use**: Fast growing tropical look is gorgeous when planted with Mandevilla and Petunias.
- **Exposure/Soil**: - Grows best in some shade but can tolerate full sun. Prefers Southwestern exposure. Mulch heavily around the plant in the fall.
- **Growth**: Can grow 5' to 6' and tolerates winter temperatures into the 20deg Fahrenheit.
- **Hardiness**: 7b-11, tender perennial, houseplant
- **Foliage**: Makes a beautiful foliage plant with outstanding yellow variegation.
- **Flower**: Following warm winters produces large pendent inflorescence with white and pink porcelain like flowers. Flowers are like the regular shell ginger.
