Alstroemeria sp. 'Pink or Red'

- **Use:** Extremely suited as a (perennial) garden and patio plant. These distinguish themselves from other alstroemeria, because these varieties possess specific characteristics, which make them well suited for your garden. The plants can last through the winter when planted in the ground and the flower stems are sturdy. Also, the stems reach sufficient length, allowing them to be picked for cut flower arrangements in the home.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun- part sun. Water the soil when the top 3" are dry. Must amend the soil if you have red clay.
- **Growth:** Grows 12" tall and 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. If the stems that have finished flowering are regularly pulled out (instead of pinched or cut), the rhizome will be stimulated to make even more new shoots. Twist and pull out the stems.
- **Flower:** Blooms spring to fall, but slowing in severe heat.
