## *Aquilegia x hybrid 'Origami Red & White'*

- **Use:** Beginning in late spring, for 12 glorious weeks, this semi-dwarf columbine produces an extravaganza of enormous, showy 2-3" red and white blooms. It's resistant to deer and rabbits. Columbines are one of the easiest and most rewarding of all perennials. Their flowers are a treasure in spring and when they are through flowering their waxy green foliage continues to add grace to the garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun– shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Tolerates a wide range of soil as long as it is well drained.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 16-18" tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Glaucous leaves are lobed.
- **Flower:** Extra large red flowers with white centers are held upright on compact plants. Cheery color for informal woodland gardens and formal mixed borders and containers. Blooms 1st year.
