

Bridal Veil Astilbe



Astilbe arendsii 'Bridal Veil'

- **Use:** Great for use in planters and in the garden! Excellent for use as a cutflower, deer resistant, and attracts hummingbirds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** **Prefers part sun!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. **Keep soil moist** watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** This compact type grows 20-22" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9 perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Leaves are bronze-red in spring, turning mid-green by summer. Do not cut it back in the winter, but early spring.
- **Flower:** Pure white blossoms held above vivid green foliage. Essential to partially shaded borders. Use in woodland gardens for contrast against darker foliated plants and to accent other Astilbe colors. Perfect in masses for moonlight gardens



Beautiful if used as a cut flower and attracts butterflies & hummingbirds, yet is deer resistant.
