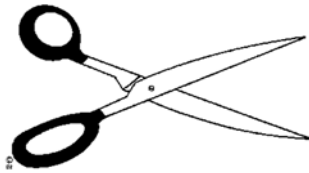


Pink Astilbe

Astilbe 'Key Biscayne'

- **Use:** More compact and longer blooming than other Astilbes. Great for use in planters and in the garden! Deer resistant and nice for cutflowers.
- **Exposure/Soil: Prefers part sun!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 20-22" tall and comes back every
- year.
- **Hardiness: Zone 3-9** perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Unique two tone foliage with a red edge.
- **Flower:** Light pink plumes on reddish stems in mid to late summer.
