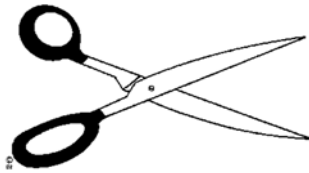


Pink Astilbe

Astilbe 'Key Largo'

- **Use:** More compact and longer blooming than other Astilbes. Great for use in planters and in the garden! Deer resistant and nice for cutflowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** **Prefers part sun!** Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 16-20" tall and 18-24" wide comes back every year.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 3-9** perennial. Mulch around plant in the winter. Make sure they have well drained soil in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deer resistant! Finely dissected, shiny kelly green foliage darkens as it ages
- **Flower:** Bright, raspberry pink plumes on reddish stems in mid to late summer.
