

Birch's Bellflower



Campanula x Birch'

Free-flowering and quick-growing, it is a joy in the woodland or rock garden! Nice, tidy habit is well-suited for walls and crevices, edging, rock gardens and containers. Excellent cut flowers.

- **Use:** Profuse blooming with nodding cup shaped flowers of purple blue. Excellent for walls and crevices this poscharskyana and garganica cross (hybrid) will bloom all summer long.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Short, mounding ground cover with a sprawling habit approximately 4-10" tall. Space 20" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Showy cup-shaped, purple-blue flowers appear over a long season from mid-spring into summer.
