

Cariboo Blue Bellflower



Campanula 'Cariboo Blue'

- **Use:** A compact hybrid with large, front-facing lavender-blue flowers that bloom for months. Does not set seed like others. Nice filler for container combinations or at the front of a border. The perfect drift of color in naturalized areas. A favorite perennial for rock gardens. Prepared to flower heavily right through summer, this small plant adds a lot of charm to the perennial garden, woodland, and rockery!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Grows to 14-18in. tall, spreads to 8-12 in wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Outward facing lavender-blue flowers bloom profusely on upright foliage in late spring.



Try in combination with Dianthus 'Firewitch' and Stachys 'Helene von Stein' near the front of the border.
