

# Pink Octopus Bellflower



**These flowers, along with the deeply cut, light green leaves make an attractive and unusual mat forming perennial.**



## ***Campanula 'Pink Octopus'***

- **Use:** Japanese lantern buds open to striking pink, octopus-like flowers. Over 50 blooms flutter down from the nicely upright flowering branches above strong, deeply cut foliage. Unique and interesting! Long bloom time and easy to grow. This spreader does very well in the South. Tolerant of most soils. Vigorous!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Loves moist soil conditions.
- **Growth:** Grows to 10" tall and 15" wide. 18" high in flower.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color and forms a thick mat in dry areas.
- **Flower:** Narrow pink petals form unique octopus-like flowers. Very floriferous and long blooming. Attracts hummingbirds.
