

Carpathian Harebell



Campanula carpatica 'Rapido Blue'

- **Use:** A favorite perennial for rock gardens. Prepared to flower heavily right through summer, this small plant adds a lot of charm to the perennial garden, woodland, and rockery!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full–part sun Water when top 3” of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Grows to 5 to 7in. tall, spreads to one foot wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Rich violet-blue blooms appear about a month sooner than other Harebells on this exciting new series from seed! Rapido earns its name as the first buds appear in spring, quickly opening into glorious 2-inch bells.

Free-flowering and quick-growing, it is a joy in the woodland or rock garden!
