

# Genti Blue Bellflower



**Attracting butterflies, hummingbirds, and honeybees with its bright blooms from late spring into the summer. Compact habit is perfect for small areas, borders and containers. Although no plant is completely deer proof this perennial is considered to be deer resistant. A favorite for cottage and butterfly gardens.**

## ***Campanula glomerata* 'Genti Blue'**

- **Use:** Clusters of tightly grouped, amethyst blue, bell-shaped flowers that bloom profusely throughout summer on a mounded, compact form with dark green foliage. Wonderful for use in containers, planter beds, or rock gardens. A lovely addition to cut flower arrangements.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun This is a ideal perennial for spots with morning sun. It thrives in full sun at higher elevation, mountain locations. Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 17 to 19 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Forms a mound of coarse green leaves low to the ground.
- **Flower:** Bears large clusters of bright blue flowers in late spring into summer. If desired, trim plants back to 4 inches after flowering, to rejuvenate the foliage and tidy up for the remainder of the season.
