

Clustered Bellflower



**Lovely deep blue flowers
and very easy to grow.**



***Campanula glomerata* 'Superba'**

- **Use:** Bellflowers are among the most popular of perennials. This selection will produce a low clump of large green leaves. Terrific for cutting. Plants will quickly form a large clump, so allow plenty of space when planting, or plan to reduce the size each spring. Easily divided in spring or fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Loves moist soil conditions.
- **Growth:** Grows to 1-2' tall, spreads to one foot wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8 perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The dark green thread leaf foliage makes a great contrast with the flower color.
- **Flower:** Upward facing clusters of violet 'bells' on 1-2' plants. Blooms heavily in late spring through early summer. Plants may benefit from a hard clipping back immediately after blooming, to maintain a low, compact mound and repeat bloom.
