

Serbian Bellflower



Campanula poscharskyana

- **Use:** Serbian bellflowers have an easy, undemanding habit. Flows beautifully along bed edges and through rock gardens. Excellent as a groundcover. Attracts butterflies and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full-part sun Water when top 3" of soil is dry. Looks lovely outside on the patio in planter. Loves moist soil conditions.
- **Growth:** Grows to 1' tall, spreads to 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8 perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The foliage remains evergreen in mild winters and needs to be sheared only once in a while to keep its appearance tidy.
- **Flower:** Creating a stream of lavender blue, the 1-inch-diameter star-shaped blossoms bloom reliably from late spring to early fall.

Bellflowers are among the most popular of perennials.
