Cestrum 'Orange Peel'

- **Use:** This superb and easy-to-grow introduction from the former Southern Perennials and Herbs Nursery is a cross of *Cestrum diurnum* x *Cestrum nocturnum*. For us, this superb selection has been both floriferous and winter hardy. The fast-growing woody stems are clothed in ligustrum-shaped, deer-resistant leaves and adorned from early June until frost with terminal clusters of mustard-orange flowers tipped in yellow...a hummingbird delight.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Super fast growing! Dense perennial to 4 to 5 ft. tall (or up to 8' if not pruned), 3 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-9b Annual, Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** A living bouquet of pure orange colored blossoms that, in warmer climates, last from early spring through first frost. The tubular flowers offer a sweet scent upon sunset.
