

Pink Chrysanthemum



Chrysanthemum (Dendanthremum) 'Clara Curtis'

- **Use:** A very old and reliable selection of Mum, that has stood the test of time. Plants form a bushy mound of light green leaves, bearing loose sprays of large, single deep pink daisies, each with a yellow eye. Pinching in June will help to keep plants bushy and compact. Attracts butterflies to the garden and lovely in late season bouquets. Exceptionally hardy and easy to grow.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to light shade. Moist well draining soil is best.
- **Growth:** Grows to 20-24" tall and 18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Lacy green leaves.
- **Flower:** A reblooming profusion of pretty rose-pink 2-3" flowers, blooms summer - fall.
