Colocasia (Leucocolocasia) 'Black Goblet'

- **Use:** This elephant ear that could only be described as AWE-SOME!!!! This huge, pucker-edged Colocasia will get up to 6-8 feet tall clumping with dark black leaves. A new introduction from Hans Hansen at Walter's Gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. The more water and fertilizer they get the better. Could grow in a well aerated pond.
- **Growth:** It makes a giant clump to 6-8' tall with a similar spread.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Perennial, mulch 1' around plant in fall. May only grow 3' tall after an extreme winter. The more heat you can give them the larger they will grow.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Composed of dark black leaves that are cupped to hold water during rain events.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
