

# Chartreuse Elephant Ears



Stunning in pots and around pools. Limited qty available.



## *Colocasia esculenta* 'Maui Gold'

- **Use:** The first clumping gold leaf colocasia to hit the market, forming a tight clump of stems that arch to 4', each ending in a large chartreuse golden leaf, highlighted by a small purple dot where the petiole connects. Serves as a nice foil to black elephant ears such as Colocasia 'Black Magic'
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. The more water and fertilizer they get the better. Could grow in a well aerated pond.
- **Growth:** It makes a giant clump to 4' tall with a similar spread.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-10, perennial, mulch 1' around plant in fall
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Chartreuse leaves are stunning against black leaves and flowers.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
