Delosperam cooperi 'Alan's Apricot'

- **Use:** The softly shaded apricot and yellow tints of the large flowers of Alan's Apricot Ice Plant are a delight and keep the plant in color from late spring into late summer. Delosperma 'Alan's Apricot' is a cold hardy ice plant 2016 Plant Select® Winner. Hardy, succulent gray-green foliage is ideal for borders, hillsides, rock gardens and other tough sites.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 4" tall and to 1-1.5" wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4a-10b perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter. Hardy to -10 degrees F.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Fringed blooms change color from apricot to pink from May– October.
