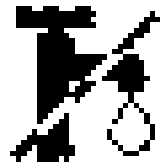


# Delmara Orange Ice Plant



## *Delosperma 'Delmara Orange'*

- **Use:** Vibrant orange blossoms cover the succulent foliage from late spring through late summer. Tumbles beautifully over rocks, slopes, banks and in a container. Low-growing, drought tolerant and a reliable evergreen groundcover. Perfectly sized for rock gardens and border fronts.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Tolerates poor soil, heat and drought. Best if planted in gritty, sharply drained soil. Allow soil to dry between thorough waterings. Remove faded flowers for the best display.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 3-4" tall and to 18" wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. When not in bloom, the small, needle-like succulent foliage of brightest green reaches just 1 to 2 inches high.
- **Flower:** Large, neon orange, daisy-like flowers with yellow centers cover a spreading mat of succulent, blue green foliage.
