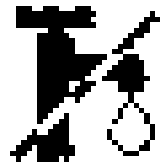


Delmara Pink Ice Plant



Delosperma 'Delmara Pink'

- **Use:** Great rating from 2018 UGA garden trails. Large, neon pink, daisy-like flowers with white centers cover a spreading mat of succulent, blue green foliage. Wonderful as a groundcover or in containers or baskets.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 3-4" tall and to 18" wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. When not in bloom, the small, needle-like succulent foliage of brightest green reaches just 1 to 2 inches high.
- **Flower:** The large hot pink flowers will be the highlight of your late spring garden when this durable groundcover comes into bloom and continues until fall.
