

Granita Orange Ice Plant



Delosperma 'Granita Orange'

- **Use:** Have your granita and eat it too! This high performing new ice plant, like it's kin GRANITA® Raspberry, closely hugs the ground, vigorously spreads and is densely covered with large flowers in varying shades of rusty orange that are at once bright, earthy and iridescent. A beautiful way to enhance your garden, provide nectar for bees, and save water at the same time.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 1-2' tall and to 10-14" wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. When not in bloom, the small, needle-like succulent foliage of brightest green reaches just 1 to 2 inches high.
- **Flower:** Richly colored orange blossoms are very abundant, they begin in late spring and continue in waves all spring, summer, and into fall. You just won't believe the bloom strength of this perennial groundcover powerhouse!



Comes back every year, deer resistant, heat tolerant, and drought tolerant.
