

# Opal Ice Plant

## *Delosperam cooperi* 'Opal'

- **Use:** There has never been a hardy iceplant like the Jewel of Desert series. Solid lavender-pink petals with just a hint of white near the base. Long-blooming, and nicely trailing, this makes the perfect 'spiller' in containers. Hardy, succulent gray-green foliage is ideal for borders, hillsides, rock gardens and other tough sites. Attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 2-4" tall and to 2-3' wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dense mat of succulent bluish foliage
- **Flower:** Lovely two tone coral and salmon pinwheel blooms over tight blue-green foliage
