

Pumpkin Perfection Desert Ice Plant



Deer resistant, perennial, heat tolerant, and drought tolerant. Ideal for large plantings, accents, and containers, they are long-lasting and neon-bright in the sun-soaked garden.

- **Use:** Hardy ice plants are known for their bright, pure colors and outstanding performance in hot, sunny spots. The Hot Cakes series takes even that to a whole new level, with intense color and a neat and tidy habit that covers the ground in a lush carpet of succulent green foliage graced with blooms all summer long. We adore the juicy bright orange of this variety, on its own or paired with any of the other six fabulous colors in this series developed by renown succulent breeder Chris Hansen. Attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Low growing plants grow 6" tall and to 1-2' wide or more.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dense mat of succulent foliage
- **Flower:** Part of a series with more fragrant flower power than others, and a tight, flat "pancake" foliage growth habit. This one has rich Halloween orange petals and white centers.
