

Summer Colors Delphinium



Stately and breathtaking. Magnificent dense racemes make delphinium excellent in the border and as a cutflower.

Delphinium grandiflorum 'Summer Colors'

- **Use:** This series is earlier to flower with better heat tolerance than other delphiniums of this type. Blooms first year.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in part sun in our area, full sun up North. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers. If you are not good at watering we recommend using **Soil Moist**.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-14" tall and 1' wide. Shorter height means less likely to need staking
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8, Perennial Save seeds for following year to resow.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Finely cut leaves.
- **Flower:** The smallest delphinium we have seen, only a foot tall, but still covered with big, dramatic blooms. The color range includes a mixture of blues, purples, and white. Attracts hummingbirds.
