

Coral Reef Dianthus



Dianthus are perfectly suited for rock gardens and exposed hills, preferring well-drained, windswept spots to boggy, stagnant ones.



Dianthus 'Coral Reef'

- **Use:** The Scent First™ Pot series of Dianthus are specifically bred for magnificent fragrance, color and form, making them heavenly additions to bouquets and cutflower arrangements. 'Coral Reef' features frilly, feminine blooms that are coral pink with white edging. These blooms produce a strong, spicy scent that is even more noticeable when you cut them!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to part sun. Moderate water requirements, but somewhat drought tolerant. Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Pro Mix Soil.
- **Growth:** Grows up to 18 inches wide and 12 inches tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; glaucous blue-green foliage
- **Flower:** These easy-to-grow little perennials flaunt their coral-and-white blooms from early spring all the way until fall. Remove spent flowers and fertilize occasionally to encourage the most re-blooming.
