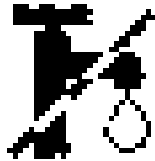


Raspberry Surprise Dianthus



Dianthus 'Raspberry Surprise'

- **Use:** The mounding, blue green, evergreen foliage on Raspberry Surprise makes a great groundcover in borders, edging and mixed containers. It is extremely floriferous and easy to grow, with dazzling double pink, scented blooms with a burgundy center in spring.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** The habit is compact and mounding to a height of about 12" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** The evergreen, glaucous grey-green foliage provides a stark contrast for these shockingly showy flowers.
- **Flower:** Very fragrant, double, pink blossoms with a red center. Even more wonderful, the flowers exude the spicy scent of cloves. Though budding is most prolific in early summer, plants often re-bloom in the fall. Prune off old flowers for longest bloom time.
