

Dianthus Starburst



Dianthus 'Starburst' (PP 21162)

- **Use:** Border Pinks have been popular in gardens for centuries. The flowers are held erect on long, upright stems over a compact mound of blue-green, grassy foliage. Flowers have a spicy fragrance. Attractive to butterflies. Great cut flower. Excellent for edging, in rock gardens and containers. The flower petals of all types of Dianthus are edible.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established. Plants require good drainage and are an excellent choice for hot dry sites or gravelly soils.
- **Growth:** Compact mounding habit 4-8" tall x 6-8" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glaucous grey-green foliage provides a stark contrast for these shockingly bright flowers.
- **Flower:** This selection produces large, semi-double, frilly, cherry-red flowers splashed with white. Repeat blooming. Even more wonderful, they exude the spicy scent of cloves. Remove spent flowers for continuous bloom.
