

Dwarf Purple Bicolor Barbarini Sweet William



Dianthus barbatus "Purple Bicolor Barbarini"

- **Use:** With its attractive, full size Sweet William–type flower heads and extended bloom time, Barbarini is well suited for perennial borders, mass plantings, patio planters and mixed containers. Butterflies love the intense color, and it is a deer resistant plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 6-12" tall x 12" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 3-8, Perennial / Reseeding Biennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a low, dense mound of attractive green foliage.
- **Flower:** Purple with lavender margined flower heads Repeat blooms if promptly sheared after spring flush and can continue into fall.
