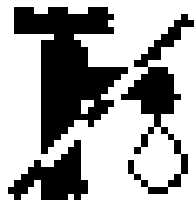


Dwarf Red Picotee Sweet William



Dianthus barbatus "Red Picotee"

- **Use:** With its attractive, full size Sweet William-type flower heads and extended bloom time, Barbarini is well suited for perennial borders, mass plantings, patio planters and mixed containers. Butterflies love the intense color, and it is a deer resistant plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 6-12" tall x 12" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8, Perennial / Reseeding Biennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a low, dense mound of attractive green foliage.
- **Flower:** This dwarf hybrid strain produces showy clusters of fragrant flowers with cherry-red petals delicately edged in white. Repeat blooms if promptly sheared after spring flush and can continue into fall.
