

# Dianthus Delilah Purple Bicolor



## *Dianthus 'Delilah Purple Bicolor'*

- **Use:** Long blooming time of 4-5 months! Highly valued rock garden plant or tightly spaced as edging and masses. Small size and long blooming color is perfect for troughs and pots. Essential to cottage garden and perennial border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 10" tall and 14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Plants produce a low, dense mound of attractive silvery blue -gray foliage.
- **Flower:** This diminutive charmer sends up fragrant, semi-double purple & white flowers above a carpet of gray-green, grassy foliage. With deadheading, it's a long-bloomer that graces the garden with flowers from spring to fall.
