Dicleptra suberecta

- **Use:** An ultimate hummingbird magnet and “must have” Summer thru Fall bloomer! Hummingbirds & Butterflies! Extremely drought tolerant. Excellent for perennial borders, and containers. Resistant to heat, drought and humidity.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Good drainage is a must!!! Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 20" tall x 3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a to 10b; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Gray felty leaves.
- **Flower:** Starting in mid-Summer, tons of long-lasting, rich coral, tubular flower clusters burst out all over, tempting hummers from near and far.
