Digitali purpurea 'Foxy Mix'

- **Use:** Spikes of creamy-white, mauve and pink flowers with spotted throats bolt out of the rosette of leaves. Extraordinary cut flower. Plants form a low rosette of coarse, hairy leaves in the first year, bursting into flower the second spring, Essential to cottage gardens and perennial borders. May naturalize where conditions are right. Attracts hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant.

CAUTION: Toxic if eaten.

- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun– part shade, very easy to please. Provide acidic (most GA soil already is), well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 2-4' tall or more and 18" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial; reseeding biennial/ perennial; Make sure that heavy mulch is removed around the plants to allow seeds to drop and sprout.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Soft, fuzzy leaves.
- **Flower:** This compact selection produces flowers in a range of soft pastel shades, from cream to pink and rose.
