

Double Scoop Raspberry Coneflower



Echinacea 'Double Scoop Raspberry'

- **Use:** Such a rare color for Echinacea, this selection boasts saturated cranberry red, double pom-pom flowers that don't bleach out as they age, putting on a sizzling hot show of color in the landscape for several months beginning in early summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part sun(6+hr).. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 24-26" tall " in. tall and 16-22" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Giant, raspberry red, double flowers that bloom throughout summer on a vigorous and compact plant. Be sure to leave some spent blooms on the plants in the fall because their seeds provide winter food for finches and other birds. The dried seed heads also provide architectural interest in the winter.

Easy to grow and unusual wildflower! The showy blooms are an excellent cut flower. Use to infuse vibrant color into sunny borders, mixed beds, and waterwise gardens.
