

# Kismet Intense Orange Coneflower



## *Echinacea 'Kismet Intense Orange'*

**Easy to grow  
wildflower that  
blooms from  
spring until frost!**

- **Use:** This one has amazed us with its long bloom time and the sheer number of blooms. All of this in addition to intense orange blooms that remain attractive for weeks and great bloom size on an upright, compact habit. Blooms keep coming from early summer until frost. Years of persistent Echinacea breeding has certainly paid off. ultimate butterfly magnet, and the top specimen for color in the sunny border. Allow dried flower heads to remain on plants for wintering songbirds. An herbaceous perennial. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 18 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** The sheer number of flowers is astounding! Multi-tone shades of flashy orange flowers mature to rich pumpkin tones. A long-lasting show from summer to frost. Lovely as a cutflower.
