- **Use:** Bright white blooms on compact mounds of green foliage over an exceptionally long season. A fuss-free, cheerful choice for a low maintenance, sunny summer border. A wonderful addition to a cutting garden. Cold hardy and drought tolerant when established.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 18 to 20 in. tall, 22 to 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Exquisite, pure white blooms are the showpiece of this new member of the esteemed Sombrero® series of Coneflower breeding, famous for their excellent winter hardiness and compact, well branched habit. Huge, single flowers with overlapping snowy white petals surround a large brown cone, making Sombrero® Blanco the perfect way of making companion plants really "pop" in a mixed container or sunny border planting. Long lasting as a cut flower, and attractive to butterflies. Flowers abound in early summer, then continue until frost.
