Echinacea 'Sombrero Flamenco'

- **Use:** Big, bright orange-red petals surround brown center cones, forming showy blooms ideal for easy, colorful summer borders and cutting gardens. Bred for cold hardiness and a compact form with prolific flowering over an exceptionally long season. Allow dried flower heads to remain on plants for wintering songbirds. An herbaceous perennial. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 24 to 26 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** Produces very large, single flowers with bright orange-red petals surrounding a brown cone. Lovely as a cutflower.
