Echinacea 'Sombrero Lemon Yellow'

- **Use:** Bright yellow blooms sure to brighten a summer border! A must-have for a cutting garden, this drought tolerant perennial was bred for cold hardiness and compact form with prolific flowering over an exceptionally long season. Keep dried flower heads on the plants in the fall for winter interest. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 24 to 26 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green oval leaves are rough to the touch.
- **Flower:** A vibrant Coneflower with an abundance of brilliant golden-yellow flowers, 3 in. across (7 cm), adorned with a skirt of wide, overlapping, drooping petals surrounding a copper central cone. Long bloom season of spring– fall. Use for cutflowers.
