Echinacea purpurea 'Double Delight'

- **Use:** Sturdy stems hold spectacular pink flowers with centers that explode with hundreds of tiny florets. Flowers appear spring to fall on sturdy stems that make them perfect for cutting. Attracts butterflies and drought tolerant. As a specimen, in borders, or massed. Good choice for meadow or prairie gardens. Deer resistant, drought tolerant. Attracts butterflies
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 16 in. tall, 12 in. wide, with flower stems to 20 in. tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long oval leaves.
- **Flower:** Large 4-5" double pom pom rose pink flowers spring to fall.
